

Trebon, Mani Shine at Colorado CX Races

Boulder, Colorado - Felt-sponsored cyclocross racers Ryan Trebon and Caroline Mani powered their way to podium performances on back-to-back UCI events October 29-20 in Boulder, Colorado.



Trebon, the No. 1 ranked man in American 'cross racing, put in a dominating performance to win Saturday's Colorado Cross Classic. Riding his Felt F1X, he joined a lead group early, then eventually powered away from a strong field including U.S. national champion Todd Wells, American Jamie Driscoll and Belgian Ben Berden.

"It took me a while to find a rhythm, and once I did I was able to get an advantage over Todd and hold it to the finish," Trebon told Cyclingnews.com after his win.

The following day Trebon showed great form again, finishing second to Berden at the Boulder Cup race, held at the new Valmont Bike Park.

The course featured steep run-ups, a long stair section and some mud left over from a snowstorm a few days before the race.

Mani, who is also racing on the Felt F1X, rode to a strong second-place finish Saturday and third place on Sunday. The French national champion is currently residing in and racing in the U.S.

Mani attacked early in Saturday's race at the Boulder Reservoir, leading the opening lap. She eventually finished second to American Katie Compton, the No. 1 ranked female in the world. Mani followed up with another strong performance Sunday, finishing third behind Compton and Georgia Gould.

Carey Wins Boulder Cyclocross #3

Broomfield, Colorado - Amanda Carey of the Kenda-Felt mountain bike team won the third round of the Boulder Cyclocross Series Sunday at Interlocken Park in Broomfield, Colorado.



Carey, who specializes in endurance off-road events throughout the summer months, topped a field of 28 women on her Felt F1X 'cross bike, beating second-place finisher Alison Powers by 12 seconds.

Last month Carey wrapped up her overall win at the 2011 National

Ultra Endurance Series. She dominated the series of marathon XC events around the country, winning races in Tennessee, Arkansas, Michigan, Oregon, Wyoming and Utah. Carey also finished fourth at the 2011 USA Cycling Marathon National Championships.

Middaugh Top-5 at XTERRA Worlds

Kapalua, Maui — Felt-sponsored multisport athlete Josiah Middaugh posted a strong top-five finish at the XTERRA World Championships in Maui, Sunday. Middaugh, a 33-year-old from Vail, Colorado, was the top American finisher in fourth, just over two minutes behind Austrian winner Michael Weiss.

Middaugh, who won the XTERRA Mountain Championship earlier this summer in Beaver Creek, Colorado, used his Felt Edict full-suspension XC bike to conquer the Kapalua course, which featured a number of power climbs and tricky descents. It was a new course for the field of 675 racers.

Middaugh was the only American to finish in the top-10. His fellow American and seven-time Tour de France winner Lance Armstrong finished 23rd.
